Methodology

- □ The questionnaire was fielded May--August 2015.
- Planters were individually invited to complete the online survey by email, phone, and postcard.
- This report provides analysis of 843 church plants started in 2008 or later that continue to exist today and were started as new church plants.




Methodology




















Average number of new commitments to Christ, by year




































Spouse's involvement in new church work








Worship Attendance Significant factors for higher worship attendance

All values shown are average attendance numbers for each factor level










Congregation starting at least one daughter church in three years






Planter receiving financial compensation in first 5 years








Majority Unchurched

 - "Unchurched" includes the percent previously completely unchurched and the percent unchurched for many years among the people attending the new church work since it began




Self-Sufficiency

All values shown are percentage of churches who reached self-sufficiency among those who started prior to or during 2012


















