- 1. "They let me mess up and make my own choices."
- 2. "When I told my parents about my unplanned pregnancy, they supported me fully."
- 3. "They don't offer unsolicited advice."
- 4. "They celebrate my victories and mourn my losses."
- 5. "They listen to me."



Survey says...

- 6. "They give me space to grow, take risks, and fail."
- 7. "By letting me go and giving me space."
- 8. "They trust I did a good job and I know what I'm doing."
- 9. "Giving me freedom to make my own traditions."
- 10. "By actively getting to know me as an adult."

Four Tips for Maintaining Healthy Relationships

- 1. Trust your adult children to make good choices, even if sometimes they don't.
- 2. Squelch the impulse to give advice unless it is asked for.
- 3. Communication is key.
- 4. Practice grace.
