The Christian church has been the **bedrock** of American life for centuries, but much has **changed** in the last 30 years as the church's influence on America has been fading.


Pew research states, "The **decline** of Christianity continues at a **rapid rate**."

The Church in America

Median Size: 137 in 2000; 55 in 2022

60-90% plateaued or are in decline.

3500-7000 churches close every year As many as 100,000 are showing signs of decline toward death
